He also was a member of many committees including Audit, Strategic Planning and Fundraising. John served as the chairman of Human Resources Committee. Additionally, Mr. Prol continues to serve on the Foundation Board. Dr. Nieuwenhuis served as chairman of the Spiritual Development committee and was a member of the Strategic Planning Committee. Their dedication and service will have a lasting impact on the ECCR. New Board Members Walt Williams, Timothy Babjak and John Driesse were welcomed at the meeting. Judy Zuidema-Dedio is beginning her second term.

At the meeting the ECCR Ladies Auxiliary presented the Board of Directors with a \$50,000 donation. These funds were raised by the various activities the group conducts including the Country Fair and the Fashion Show. Ladies Auxiliary President, Theresa Bushman and Treasurer, Jean Kort presented the check. The Ladies Auxiliary celebrated their 40th anniversary this year. It was the tireless perseverance of this group along with their faith that resulted in the creation of the Eastern Christian Children's Retreat.

Happy New Year to all of our friends, families and supporters! This past year has truly been an eventful one here at ECCR, as well as in the rest of the country. I feel so blessed to be able to write this column for such a special organization that serves our special people. The hurricanes that affected the Gulf Coast were devastating to everyone who lived in that area and the affects have been felt throughout the country and it will be years before the healing has begun. During that time there were many thoughts and discussions about people with disabilities and how they were coping with this tragedy. It was unthinkable for us to consider how they were able to handle such a crisis, especially with limited mobility and resources to get out of the affected areas. The staff at ECCR wanted to do something to help the victims, so we took up a collection and donated over \$1100 to the American Red Cross.

This past year, we have been truly blessed in being able to hire a full time Chaplain, Aaron Jager, and a part time Assistant, Eric Fluit. We have been able to increase opportunities for our residents to participate in worship services both here and in the community.

This past year has been very difficult with many hospitalizations and untimely deaths, and their presence here has been very helpful for the residents, families and staff involved in these situations. ECCR is always looking for others to contribute to the spiritual development of the residents and would welcome visitors and volunteers from the community to assist in our services. We are thankful for the new Board members who joined us in November. We are grateful to the volunteer Board of Directors who spend countless hours helping to guide the Administration in decisions that are best for the ECCR. They work on many committees and volunteer to help at many functions. Besides the Fair, Board members also help with the Beefsteak, and support other fundraisers. They even cook hamburgers and hot dogs for staff at employee barbeques!

I am hopeful and optimistic that 2006 will be a good year for ECCR. I am confident that the Lord will provide for us as he has for over 33 years. However difficult the work may become, all we need to do is talk to one of the residents for a few minutes and we are reminded of the reason for our existence. 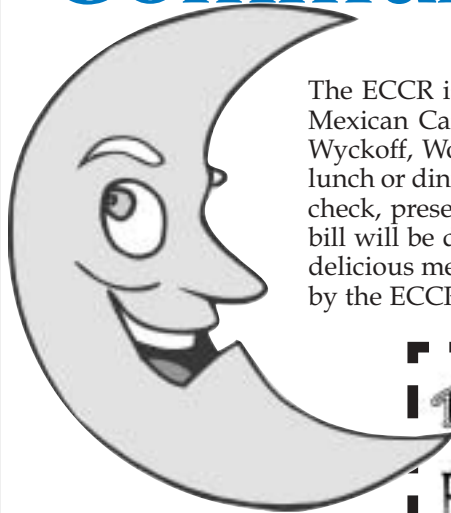
A caring, skilled and dedicated staff minister to the residents, guided by our Christian calling and principles.

As a child, I have a vivid memory of a poster that hung in the basement of my home. Prominently displayed on the poster along with the picture of a not-so-beautiful pig was this quote: "A thing of beauty is a joy forever!" Intended with ironic humor, I believe that it helps illustrate a point about our cultural confusion over the word "beauty". We seem to have a preoccupation with beauty which is sometimes humorous, at other times cruel but more than anything, frighteningly obsessive. On billboards, advertisements in magazines, words and pictures on radio and TV tell us that we can look "beautiful". But can this kind of beauty really last? Deep inside, we know that this external beauty is like a falling snowflake - you can hold it in your hand for a moment but then it melts away. What would our beauty-obsessed culture say when asked if a disabled child or adult can be beautiful? What would God say? 2 Samuel 16: 7 writes "The Lord does not look at the things man looks at. Man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart." God redefines our image of beauty by pointing us to the heart of a person and it is there that we truly see what they look like. Here at ECCR, one of the purposes of the Spiritual Development department is to nurture and display what God sees as beautiful in the heart of each resident. By helping each person grow more into the likeness of Jesus we will see beauty blossom all around. So the next time you walk the halls of the Eastern Christian Children's Retreat be aware of the beautiful people blooming before your eyes! A person of beauty is truly an eternal joy in the eyes of God!
